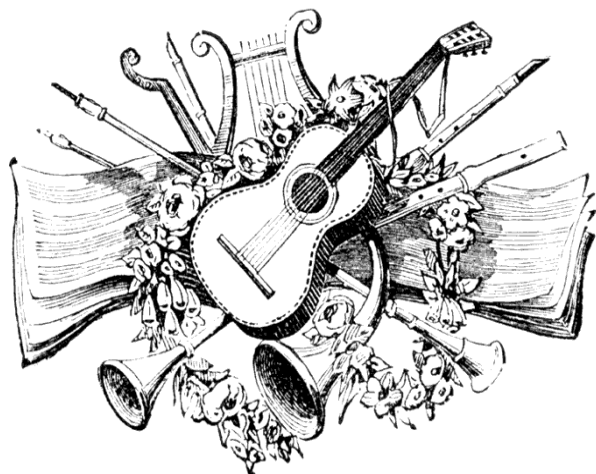

For any orchestral instrument or piano:

- Improve your rhythm
- Learn to play your part well while everyone else plays something different
- Improve your sense of pitch
- Learn strategies to build unity within a group

Registration Requirements:

- Own/bring your own instrument (except for keyboard players).
- Have a beginning knowledge of how to play your instrument.
- Schedule an audition to take place at the end of May (for placement purposes).

Each Session Features:

- **Students may sign up individually or as an established group.** Groups will be guaranteed to stay together for one of the two ensembles. Individuals will be placed in appropriate ensembles
- **2 chamber ensembles:** Each student in the camp is assigned two ensembles (playing different music). Each ensemble has time with a coach and uncoached rehearsal time daily.
- **Daily structured recreation:** We all need downtime in order to rejuvenate our minds and bodies and prepare us for the focus required for playing chamber music.
- **Recording** for family and friends of the final performance.
- **Audition** for placement.
- If there is enough interest, we may offer a jazz track for one ensemble per interested student.
- Students may register for one or both sessions. Students who register for both will have different music assignments at each session.
- **Performance** suitable for inviting family and friends to hear what you have been working on all week.

Your Coach will provide:

- Guidance to improve overall performance
- Counsel regarding stage presence
- Help with music selection
- Guidelines for practice strategies and rehearsal planning for small ensembles
